Westmoreland Recycling Committee Meeting, Tuesday, September 30, 2014

Our next recycling event will be held on November 1 from 10 AM – noon. We will have a truck parked in the front of the Westmoreland Town Hall for electronic recycling. We will collect anything with a cord, with the exception of TV's, CRT computer monitors and large appliances such as refrigerators, stoves, washers/dryers, etc. In addition, the Lion's Club will do an eyeglass collection and a clothing swap at the Town Hall.

Dawn will locate the last electronic recycling notice that Tim Thompson created, update the dates and post the new flyers to announce this upcoming event. Dawn will check with the Keene Sentinel and the Shopper News to see if they will advertise this non-profit event at no charge. Susan will get the word out about this event to the local churches.

We will schedule a work day on October 6 at 10 AM at the Recycling Center and will post a meeting notice accordingly.
