Dick Schmidt reviewed section 4 and 5. Traffic flow data was collected from the NH DOT website.

Carol Austin reviewed section 6, expressing concern over the County Properties. What will be the status of the County Nursing home and the impact on Westmoreland.

Tom Finnegan reviewed section 7, most members were surprised the town of Westmoreland own the ball field in E Westmoreland.

John Lukin reviewed sections 8 and 9. John noted that many parts of these sections should be removed and or moved to an appendix. Everyone agreed pages 39 to 43 would make a good reference in the appendix. John will review and bring recommendations to the next meeting.
