

The Recreation Committee met on Thursday, October,18,2018, at the Town Hall. We discussed the old business of the East Westmoreland basketball courts and will look into how often the courts are used to see if repairing them is something we want to pursue.

We discussed the cracks in the town tennis court. Jason Simino suggested we use a company in Troy called Stripe It Seal It. This company could do the repairs for about \$800.00 compared to the Vermont Tennis Court Surfacing Company that quoted \$2,230.00 The committee unanimously approved \$950.00 for the repairs and maintenance of the court.

The other project we talked about was trail repair behind the school. The trails could be really nice and a great walk for all the town folks. Mark Hayward will look into volunteers from the school to make the trails more passable. Mary Bradley suggested working on the trail leading from Maplewood down to the river. It once was a beautiful hike, but is now overgrown. Any volunteers for these projects are always welcome.

The idea of a possible public boat launch at the former jail site on River Road is on hold right now, due to the construction of the Maplewood Project.
